A Biblical Walk Through the Mass is a five-part study that provides a unique tour of the timeless Liturgy. Based on the revised translation of the Mass that goes into effect in Advent 2011, this study explores the biblical roots of the words and gestures we experience in Mass and explains their profound significance.

As you explore the biblical roots of the Catholic Liturgy, you will come to know and understand the Mass like never before. You will see, perhaps for the first time, why we say what we say and do what we do at Mass. The words and gestures will be seen in a new light, leading you to a richer, more fruitful worship experience.
