Besides offering us unique liturgical and musical opportunities, this pilgrimage will take us to the sacred sites of our Catholic faith, including the basilicas of France. Paris highlights will also include an illuminated cruise on the Seine and a tour of the Louvre Museum.

The main focus of the pilgrimage, of course, will be the Holy Spirit of God working in us through the gift of music. Our journey will conclude in Lourdes, a place of “incredible beauty,” known for its prayer and healing. We will attend Mass at the Grotto and experience the beauty of the candlelight procession as we lift our hearts and voices, singing hymns to honor the Mother of God!

We look forward to having you join us on this wonderful journey.

ITINERARY

Day 1 May 30, Monday: Depart USA

Today, depart New Orleans and Houston Intercontinental Airport via Continental and Air France for your overnight transatlantic flight to Paris. Dinner, breakfast and beverages will be served aloft. (D)

Day 2 May 31, Tuesday: Paris - Normandy

Upon arrival at Charles de Gaulle International Airport, go through Passport Control, claim your luggage, and a Peter's Way Tours tour manager/guide will meet you upon your exit from Customs. Your luggage will be transferred to your bus and soon you will be on your way to the French countryside of Rouen, the port city of Paris at the mouth of the Seine River on the English Channel. Rouen, packed with lovely churches and old half-timbered houses, is full of poignant reminders of Joan of Arc, who was burned alive here on May 30, 1431. A dazzling modern church and memorial dedicated to Joan, France's patron saint, can now be visited in the centuries-old market place where she was burned at the stake. Visit the Cathedral of Notre Dame in Rouen, which was often chosen by the French Impressionist painter, Monet, as the facade building in many of his paintings. Independent lunch. Check-in at hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Rouen/Normandy. (B,D)

Day 3 June 1, Wednesday: Lisieux - Normandy Beaches - American Cemetery - Bayeux Tapestry

Continental breakfast at hotel. This morning, we will drive to Lisieux, the home of St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus. On arrival, you will visit “Les Buissonnets,” the humble dwelling of this modern-day saint until she entered the Carmel Convent at the tender age of 15. Here lies the body of the “Little Flower” who winged her way to heaven at only 24. You will also visit the astonishing Basilica of St. Thérèse, the Crypt, plus the 13th-century Gothic Norman Cathedral of St. Peter. **Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral presented by the Our Lady of the Lake Church Choir (subject to confirmation).** Independent lunch.

Then, we visit the sites of the D-Day Landings, the Allied invasion of Normandy on June 6, 1944. Our first stop will be **Sainte-Mere-Eglise**, where some 13,000 American paratroopers dropped from the skies in the early hours of June 6, 1944 in support of the landings on Utah Beach. We continue with a **walk on Utah Beach**, where we will view the **U.S. Monument**. Our day continues to **Mulberry Harbor** at Arromanches, before visiting the **German Battery** at Longues-sur-Mer. Our D-Day sightseeing concludes with time to explore **Pointe du Hoc**, the enemy command post of the entire invasion front, which is filled with monuments and memorials. We will also visit the **American Military Cemetery of St. Laurent**, where over 9,000 Americans who died in the Normandy campaign are buried. Time will be given for prayer and reflection.

Continue to Bayeux, a city rich in Norman history and the first French town to

be liberated during the D-Day Invasion, on June 7, 1944. Visit the Gothic **Cathedrale Notre-Dame**, and the **Musée de la Tapisserie de Bayeux**, which houses the spectacular **Bayeux Tapestry**. One of the most famous tapestries in the world, it is actually embroidery on a band of linen, 231 feet long and 20 inches wide. The tapestry depicts some 58 scenes in eight colors, which tells the story of the conquest of England by William the Conqueror. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Granville-Sur Mer/Normandy. (B,D)

Day 4 June 2, Thursday: Bayeux - Mont-St-Michel - Paris

After breakfast, begin our tour in Bayeux, a city rich in Norman history and the first French town to be liberated during the D-Day Invasion, on June 7, 1944. Visit the Gothic **Cathedrale Notre-Dame**, and the **Musée de la Tapisserie de Bayeux**, which houses the spectacular **Bayeux Tapestry**. The tapestry depicts some 58 scenes in eight colors, which tells the story of the conquest of England by William the Conqueror. Then, we continue to the beautiful monastic architecture of Mont-St-Michel. You will approach this tiny island by a causeway built in 1877, and enter the medieval village of 250 inhabitants by three massive stone gates. The great Benedictine Abbey Fortress that crowns this mass of granite was begun in 1017. A monastery built on three levels was added to the church's north side in the early 13th century. **Attend the 11:00 am Mass at Mont-St-Michel followed by a mini-concert, presented by the Our Lady of the Lake Church Choir (subject to confirmation).** Independent lunch.

This afternoon, we continue for Paris, the “City of Lights.”

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Paris. (B,D)

Day 5 June 3, Friday: AM/Highlight tour of Paris - PM/At Leisure

After breakfast, our guide will bring alive the remarkable sights of this magnificent and Romantic city on the River Seine: the Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysées, Arc de Triomphe, Tomb of Napoleon, Place de la Concorde, the Opéra the Bastille Square and The Place des Vosges, the oldest square in Paris is one of the most beautiful squares in the world. End our morning with a visit to the fascinating Artist Square and Sacré Coeur Basilica, with its huge bell tower and onion-shaped domes-one of the city's most familiar sights. Independent lunch. Afternoon at leisure. This is your opportunity to explore the sights, sounds and tastes of Paris all on your own! Perhaps you may want to treat yourself to a leisurely multi-course lunch in a quaint Bistro. There are always plenty of churches, museums and squares to explore. Independent dinner.

Overnight at hotel in Paris. (B)

Day 6 June 4, Saturday: AM/Notre Dame Cathedral; Sainte Chapelle & Louvre Museum - PM/Vigil Mass at the Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris

Breakfast at your hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the Ile de la Cité, where you will visit the magnificent cathedral, Notre-Dame-de-Paris. Continue to

visit the nearby Sainte Chapelle, a masterpiece of Flamboyant Gothic architecture built by Saint Louis in the heart of the Palais de la Cité on the Ile de la Cité in Paris. Then, we continue to visit the world famous Louvre museum, which boasts nearly 60,000 square meters of exhibition space to house its vast collection. In the sculpture wing, you can see the famed *Venus de Milo* and *Winged Victory of Samothrace*. The many galleries of paintings include works from noted masters such as Rembrandt, Rubens, Raphael, Titian, and others, as well as da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*. Independent lunch. Return to your hotel to freshen up. **Around 5:00 pm, you will be transferred to the Notre Dame Cathedral for the 6:00 pm Vigil Mass, as sung by the Our Lady of the Lake Church Choir (subject to confirmation).**

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Paris.

Day 7 June 5, Sunday: AM/Chartres - PM/Formal Concert in Paris

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, we leave Paris on our excursion to Chartres, where we will visit **Chartres Cathedral**, the jewel in the crown of medieval churches in Europe and a testimony in stone to the religious fervor of the Middle Ages. Chartres Cathedral boasts an unrivaled expanse of sculpture, as well as one of Europe's most impressive collections of stained glass windows. Independent lunch. Return to your hotel to freshen up.

This afternoon, you will be transferred to La Madéleine Church, St. Sulpice or St. Clotilde for a Formal Concert, presented by the Our Lady of the Lake Church Choir. Dinner at your hotel.

After dinner this evening, enjoy a cruise on the Seine. See history spanning 1,000 years in one and one-half hours, passing 25 bridges and the main illuminated monuments of Paris.

Overnight at hotel in Paris.

Day 8 June 6, Monday: Paris - Lourdes

Leisurely breakfast at your hotel. This morning, you will be transferred to Paris Orly Airport for your continuing flight to Lourdes. Upon arrival, you will be met by your Peter's Way Tours representative. Your luggage will be transferred to your bus and soon you will be on your way to Lourdes.

A picture book castle and the "Grotto" dominate Lourdes, where the "Beautiful Lady" appeared to Bernadette. Most people have a mental image of Lourdes, which dissolves the instant they visit the town. Few are prepared by what they have read or seen in pictures to grasp the sheer beauty of the place. It is more dramatic and larger than you expect. The people you meet there are the most amazing part of the entire experience. They seem possessed of a loving spirit, which almost puts electricity in the air. At night they stroll the narrow streets singing aloud, laughing and full of joy. They come from all nations. If you cannot always understand their language, you can easily understand their smiles. Whether they experience another miracle or not, they consider it miracle enough to find themselves as pilgrims, at last, in Lourdes. Check-in at hotel in Lourdes.

Dinner at your hotel. **After dinner, participate in the evening candlelight Rosary procession.**

Overnight at hotel in Lourdes.

Day 9 June 7, Tuesday: Full day in Lourdes - PM/Concert at the Upper Basilica

Continental breakfast at your hotel.

OPTION I: Private liturgy at the Grotto.

This morning, participate in the walking tour of Lourdes, where the group will visit the places associated with the life of Bernadette. The places include the Boly Mill, where St. Bernadette was born; the Locale Mill, residence of her parents; the "Cochot," formerly used as a jail where she lived at the time of the Apparitions; the Chapel where St. Bernadette received her First Holy Communion; and the Parish church containing the Baptismal Font where she was baptized. Independent lunch.

Your afternoon is free for private devotions, visiting the Grotto, and confession. There will be an opportunity for the sick to take part in the Miraculous Baths. You may make the outdoor Stations, if you are able, and attend the Blessing of the Sick, one of the most inspiring events at the shrine.

Leisure time follows. Perhaps you will take an optional visit of the sanctuaries. In a square to the side is the Chapel of Reconciliation, where the Redemptorist Fathers are available for confessions in many languages.

OPTION II: Attend the International Mass at the Lower Basilica, at which the Our Lady of the Lake Church Choir will sing for the Mass (availability and time subject to confirmation).

OPTION III: Afternoon formal concert at the Upper Basilica, presented by the Our Lady of the Lake Church Choir.

Dinner at your hotel.

After dinner, attend the evening candlelight Rosary procession.

Overnight at hotel in Lourdes.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round-trip from New Orleans and Houston via Continental Airlines and Air France. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. By sending your deposit together with your completed reservation form before the deposit deadline, airfare will be guaranteed against future fare increases excluding tax increases or fuel surcharges. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double-bedded rooms with a cot or rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of \$695.00. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin rooms and are sometimes located away from the group in a different area of the hotel, and may be in high traffic areas, such as stairways/elevators. LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (**\$to be confirmed by July 15, 2010, per person, sharing a twin**) must notify Peter's Way Tours **in writing**, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. *Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the land only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from Hotel/Airport.
