## **OLL Mission Arizona 2010 FAQ Page:**

1. What are the dates of the Mission Trip?
  - Saturday, May 29, 2010 – Saturday June 5, 2010.
2. What are the age requirements for the trip?
  - Those entering Freshman year in high school in the fall of 2010, through those who are in college under the age of 21 are eligible to participate.
3. Where in Arizona will we be traveling?
  - We are taking a charter bus from Mandeville to Chinle, Arizona, which is located on the eastern border. In Chinle we will be working with two local catholic Churches and visiting some of the cultural sites in the area. On our final day of the trip we will be traveling to the grand canyon to spend a day there.
4. What will we be doing in Chinle?
  - Our Group will do a variety of ministries in Chinle, including: Vacation Bible School, Church Projects, Working at the Food Bank, working at the Thrift stores, and other service projects.
5. Besides service is there a spiritual element?
  - Absolutely. The focus of the mission IS its spiritual dimension. We are sent by God to be his hands and feet to the people in most need. Each day of the mission trip will include group prayer, lessons, sharing and a time for quiet reflection. Our preparation will include the same
6. What is the teen to Chaperone (21 and over) ratio for the trip?
  - 6:1 (All of our chaperones undergo Archdiocesan safe environment training, screening, and criminal background checks.)
7. Will there be other groups present?
  - No this a private trip run from the youth ministry office at Our Lady of the Lake.
8. What does the Trip cost for each attendee?
  - The total cost is **\$1075**, which covers the Charter Bus, insurance, 2 t-shirts, all meals, sleeping accommodations, water, snacks, and our day trip to the Grand Canyon. The cost will be broken down to three installments:
    1. \$ 175 non-- refundable deposit due by Feb. 26, 2010
    2. \$450 due by March 30, 2010
    3. \$450 Due by May 3, 2010; the full amount is due no later than May 3, 2010.

(Make all checks payable to OLL Mission Trip 2010... enclose payment on an envelope with participants name on envelope whenever turning in a payment.)
9. Am I guaranteed a spot as long as I get my deposit in by February 26?
  - No! There are only 40 spots limited on this trip and registration is on a first come and first serve basis for OLL teen parishioners and/or youth group members and is subject to a fully completed registration packet with deposit and verification of references. You will be contacted once your registration is confirmed or once the trip is full.
10. If I have been on an OLL mission trip before, do I get first reference to go again?
  - No. Please reference question number 9.
11. If I am a teen and not a parishioner am I able to still go on the trip?
  - Absolutely yes, granted you have turned in all necessary papers.
12. If I turn in my deposit and the trip is already filled, will I receive my deposit back?

- Yes. Your \$175 deposit will only be cashed once your registration has been confirmed. Otherwise, It will be returned to you.

13. If my registration is confirmed, but I later decided I do not want to go or I cannot go, can I get my deposit back?

- No. The \$175 deposit is non refundable once your registration has been confirmed. Once subsequent balance payments have been made, they can only be refunded to a teen who cancels if another teen can be found to fill their spot.

14. Are there any other meetings that I will need to attend leading up to the mission trip?

- Yes. Once your registration has been confirmed, you will be mailed a list of dates when we will gather to pray and prepare for our trip. The three meetings are:
  - Tuesday, March 9, 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. in Canisus Hall
  - Tuesday, April 13, 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. in Canisus Hall
  - Wednesday, May 12, 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. (Location T.B.A.).
- Attendance at these meeting is required and necessary for a successful trip for the individual and the entire group. Parents are welcomed to all these meetings and will be notified when their presence is needed to sign any documents. Attendees will also be required to assist in group fundraisers for the trip. This will be minimal, but important commitment in making sure costs beyond registration are met for Our Lady of the Lake. Fund-raising dates and details will be announced after your registration is confirmed.

MAY 29 - JUNE 5, 2010**

**VIOLATIONS OF ANY OF THE REGULATIONS LISTED BELOW MAY RESULT IN YOUR IMMEDIATE  
RETURN HOME BY COMMERCIAL CARRIER AT PARENTS' EXPENSE**

- \* All trip chaperones (those from Our Lady of the Lake as well as those at the mission site) are to be respected at all times; instructions are to be followed.
- \* Alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illegal drugs, and weapons or dangerous items of any sort are positively forbidden.
- \* Room assignments may not be changed once assigned; members of the opposite sex may not visit each others' rooms.
- \* No one is permitted to leave the area of designated activity without the permission and escort of a chaperone.
- \* Anyone damaging property will be held responsible for the cost of damages. The Archdiocese of New Orleans and Our Lady of the Lake is not responsible for damage expenses that an individual incurs. Theft of property is forbidden.
- \* If a participant uses special prescription medication (i.e. insulin, Ritalin, pain medication, etc.), the trip leader reserves the right to have a chaperone administer such medication.
- \* You must be on-time for all departures, arrivals, and other scheduled activities. Failure to follow this rule may result in loss of privileges on this or future trips.
- \* Once curfew has been established, NO ONE will be allowed out of their rooms.
- \* Please do not bring valuables such as jewelry, expensive electronics, etc. The Archdiocese of New Orleans and Our Lady of the Lake is not responsible for loss or damage that may result to such items.

- 3) Please make ALL checks payable to "Our Lady of the Lake Navajo Mission 2010" and NOT the young person.

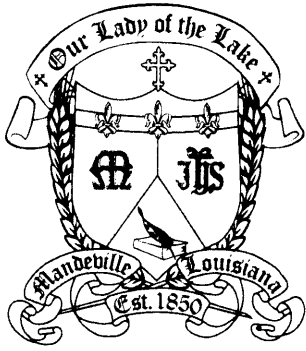

# Website Policy

Archdiocesan parishes, offices and schools are increasingly creating web pages to foster and publicize their ministries. This technology may be of assistance and several of you have mentioned to me that you are pleased with your web pages. I anticipate the number of parish/office/school web pages will continue to increase. Because of this, I would like to bring to your attention three concerns of which you should be aware.

- Possibly companies will offer to provide a web page free of charge in return for permission authorizing sale of advertisements on parish/office/school web pages. Please know this is not allowed. **No parish, office or school may permit advertisements of any nature to appear on the web pages.** If you wish further information concerning this policy, please contact Mr. Leon Mathes, Archdiocesan Chief Administrative Officer.
- Some parishes are publicizing the parish bulletins on their web page. Some people are agreeable to their names and pictures appearing in the church bulletin since the distribution of it is limited, for example, only given to those actually in church. However, some people object to their name or pictures appearing on a web page and, therefore, on the internet. Some pastors have considered publishing the list of lectors or extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist on the parish web page along with the individual's phone number in order that liturgical ministers may more easily contact each other in the event of the need for a substitute. Other pastors have considered publishing the parish directory with the names, addresses and phone numbers of parishioners. Please be aware that some people object to their phone numbers and/or addresses appearing on web pages.

Therefore, it is strongly recommended that no phone numbers or addresses appear on web pages. In addition, if the parish bulletin will appear on the parish web page, the following paragraph should be published in the bulletin for several weeks prior to the time that the bulletin is published on the internet.

Beginning on \_\_\_\_\_, 2001, the parish bulletin will also be published on the parish web site on the internet. Everyone who belongs to the parish whose name or picture may be published in the parish bulletin, or anyone who may belong to another parish but whose name or picture may be published in (name of the parish) bulletin, should be aware that their name may be published on the internet as part of the parish bulletin. **IF ANY PERSON DOES NOT WANT HIS OR HER NAME OR PICTURE IN THE BULLETIN ON THE INTERNET, PLEASE NOTIFY THE PARISH OFFICE IMMEDIATELY IN WRITING.**

Offices and schools should also be mindful of this concern and be certain that names and pictures are not used if their use would be against the will of the person involved.

Some schools and parishes also publish on their web page the names and pictures of minors. It is recommended that this be done only with the written consent of the parents or guardians. The following release form should be used:

The use of the web sites is new in our culture. Very little legislation has been enacted nor have there been court decisions which would clarify the way in which parishes/offices/schools should approach the publication of information on web sites.
