Your little one's brain continues its rapid growth. Response to sound grows more consistent toward the end of the seventh month, when the network of nerves to the ear is complete. Your baby's hearing continues to develop. Your baby's lungs continue to grow and prepare for functioning outside of the womb. He also continues to take small breaths and although he's only breathing in water and not air, it's still good practice for when he's born. Your baby's eyelids are now open more. Your baby can distinguish between light and dark. Your baby will grow over ½ inch this week alone! You may suspect this phenomenal growth rate repeats in the preteen years! Your baby is now 14.4 inches long and 1.9 pounds.

WORD OF LIFE - HHS's new mandate for contraception/sterilization coverage ... includes an incredibly narrow exemption for "religious employers" that protects almost no one. For example, a Catholic institution serving the poor and needy would have to fire its non-Catholic staff, refuse life-affirming care to non-Catholic people in need, and devote itself instead to "the inculcation of religious values" to qualify for the exemption. Individuals, insurers, and the sponsors of non-employee health plans (e.g., student health plans in Catholic schools) would have no exemption at all. This effort to corral religion exclusively into the sanctuaries of houses of worship betrays a complete ignorance of the role of religion in American life, and of Congress's long tradition of far more helpful laws on religious freedom. - *Cardinal Daniel DiNardo, Archbishop of Galveston-Houston and Chair of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities, Letter to Congress, September 7, 2011, in support of the "Respect for Rights of Conscience Act"*
